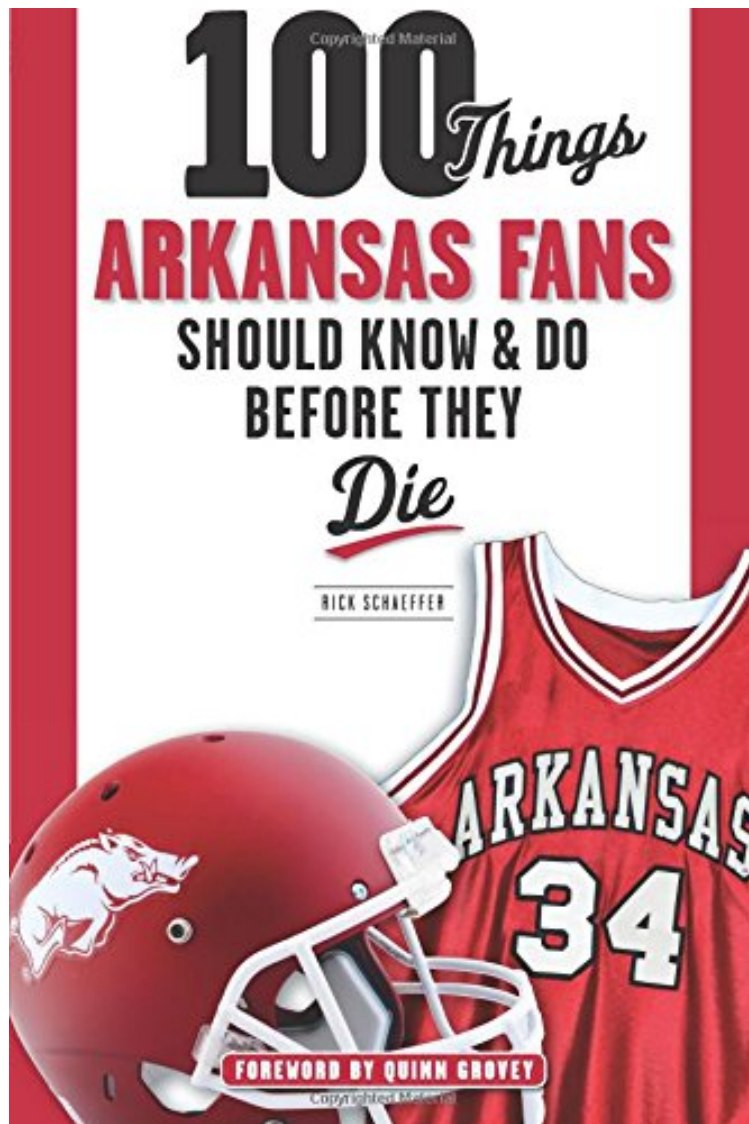

It's a collection of brief articles detailing great football and basketball players, exciting games and even sportscasters and eating establishments in the Fayetteville area. Schaeffer avoids anything controversial and instead offers the reader a pleasant walk down memory lane. Although the author includes some excellent stories from the early history of Arkansas athletics such as portraits of Hugo Bezdek, Wear Schoonover and Clyde Scott, the bulk of the book focuses on games and people over the last 25 years or so. The articles are also weighted toward football, which is understandable, although I would have enjoyed a couple of stories of earlier basketball stars like Fred Grim, Tommy Boyer or Tommy Rowland. I grew up in Arkansas and have fond memories of many of the figures and events in the book and really enjoyed revisiting them in the pages of Schaeffer's work.
