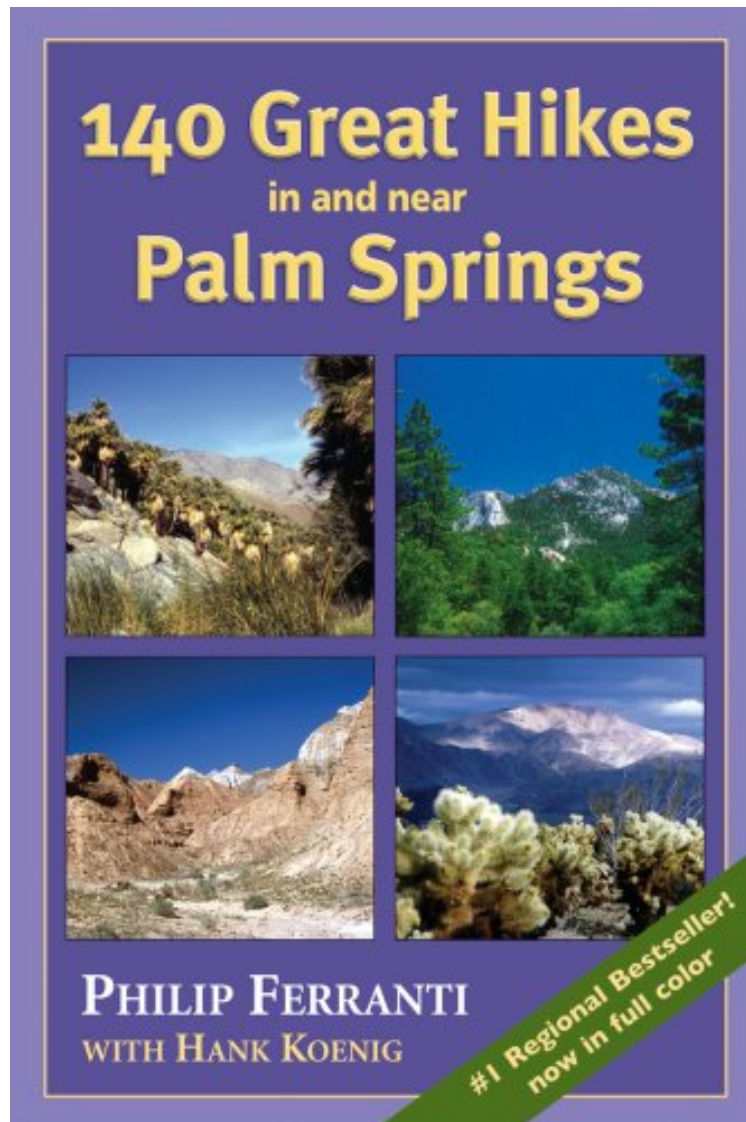

The book does a great job giving an idea of the varying kinds of hikes, from easy to quite strenuous. The hikes are also broken down by category (good with kids, old gold mines, etc.) as well as by location. There are two things which keep this book from rating 5 stars. First, the directions to some of the trailheads are poorly written and vague. Also, the

maps which accompany the text are of questionable accuracy. We found one map printed upside down, one that showed a non-existent trail junction, etc. Use this book for ideas and to get a general sense of the hike you are interested in, then get yourself a good map (locally, see Desert Map and Aerial Photography in Rancho Mirage) for when you are out walking. 2 of 2 people found the following review helpful. It's a sequel to the 100 hikes and then the 120 hikes from a few years back, but this with more hikes (obviously) and in color. Just be ware -- as with many other hiking books, not all of the hiking information is correct, although this one seems worse than most. Many distances and directions and other details are ambiguous or missing or just plain wrong. But it's still the best resource for the Palm Springs area and I use it every time I head to the area.
