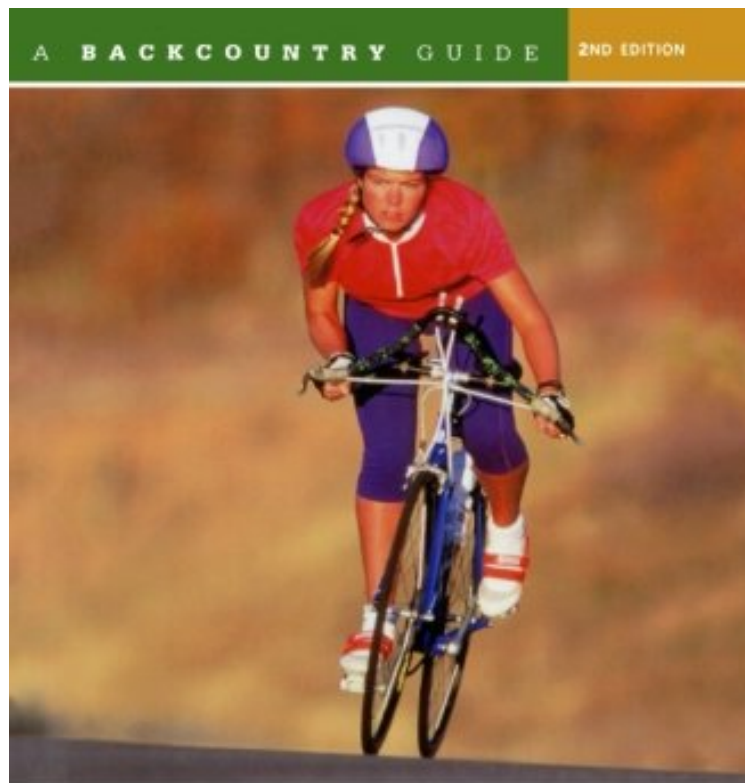

I'm not sorry I bought it... it's a great area to explore. But if you're an experienced cyclist who regularly tours with a cue sheet, you may find it frustrating. It's extremely detailed and wordy with the directions. Involves a lot more reading than I personally feel is safe to do while simultaneously navigating your bike. I wind up writing my own cue sheet w/just the turns and distances I can safely glance at. It would be better if there were a simplified version of this in the book one could just photocopy. I find it odd that this isn't included. Especially since it seems to be aimed at the moderately experienced tour enthusiast. ZutherWe bought the book and used it exclusively to prepare and conduct bicycle trips in the Hudson valley. The trip length and route layout suits the occasional to average trained cyclist. The routes are using mostly side roads which makes the trips safe and pleasant. The indication of the mileage for each step make sure that no turn or remarkable viewpoint is missed. The abstract that precedes the detailed description of each tour is a good help to pick a route for the day. We highly recommend the book to anyone who has an interest in cycling in the Hudson Valley. Hopefully there will be more cyclists in the future as this area is great to be explored and enjoyed from the bicycle.

Eastern New York along the Hudson River into Northern Westchester County, though well populated, includes some of the most scenic, quiet, rural bicycle routes available in the Northeast. Routes will carry you through rolling farmlands and stunning views throughout the region. The routes are designed for all levels of riders, some are gentle, some more strenuous, while others include a full-on work-out with steep climbs and dramatic, heart-pounding descents. This second edition includes two new tours in Westchester County, 27 routes in all! The tours begin at the northern end of the Hudson Valley. Each tour includes a map, description of the route, written milepost-style directions, special considerations, sights, attractions and bicycle repair services, complete with phone numbers.
