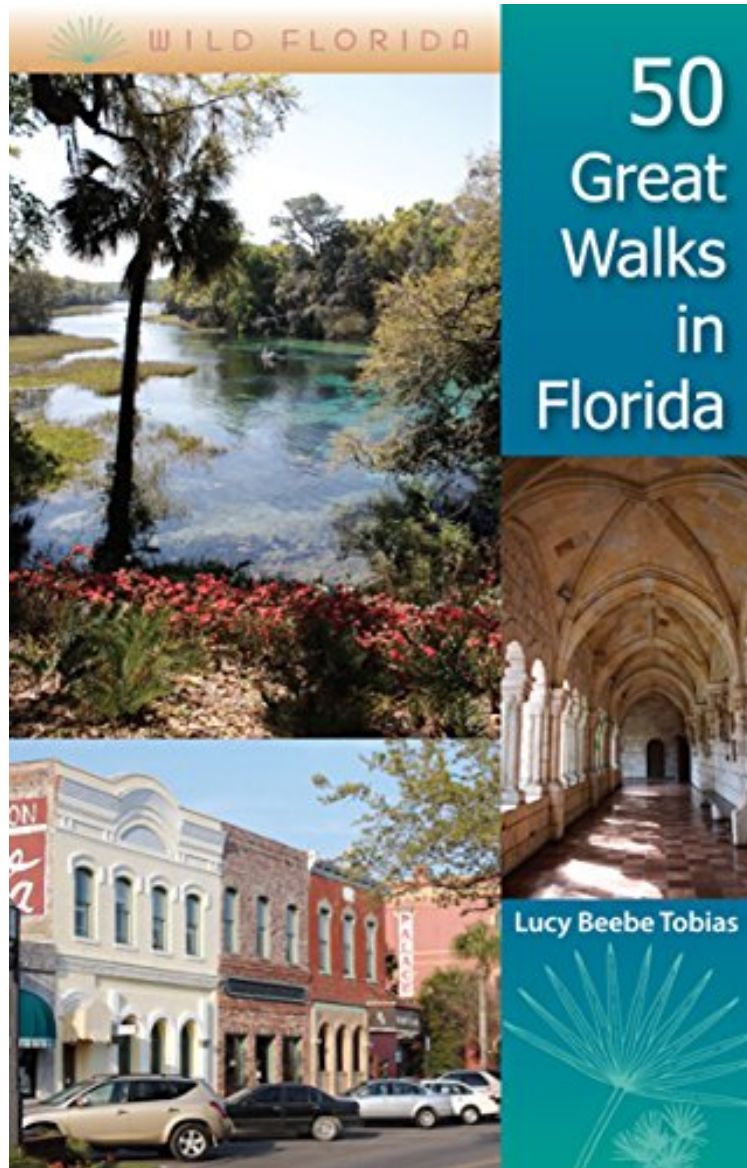

She buckled down, ranging the state for interesting walks. Each section of her finished book has a city walk, a wildlife walk, a great garden, some historic site, and one unusual place. Each walk has complete background information, such as a map, GPS coordinates (are you into geocaching?) admissions, and even lunch spots. Lucy drawls when she speaks.
