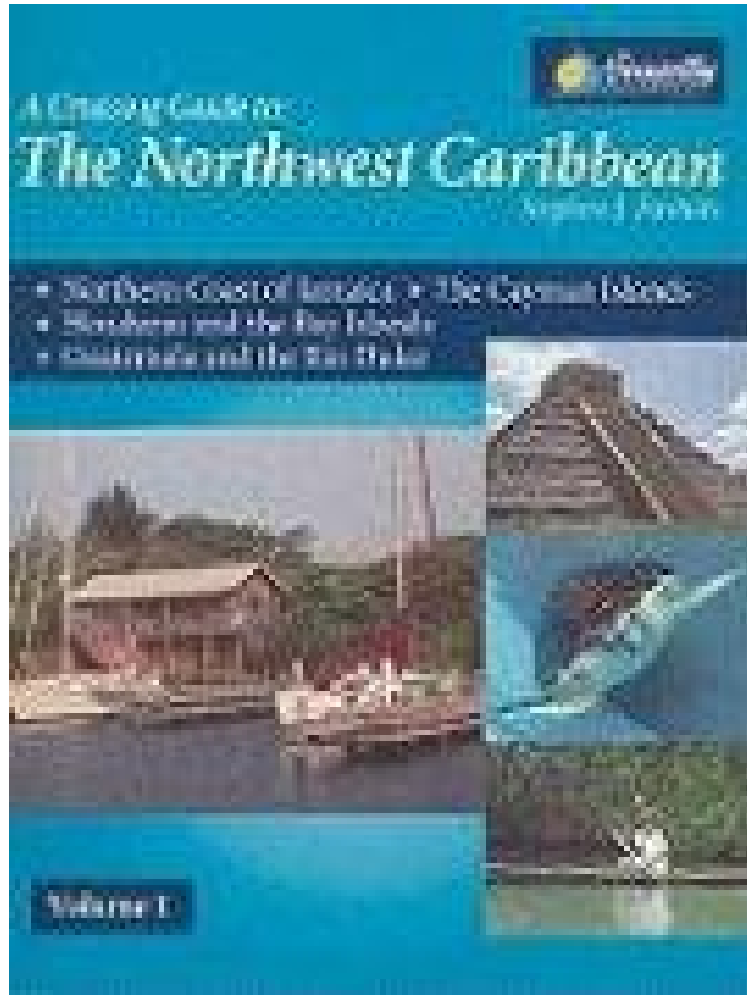

Its also refreshing to see no advertising, no blustery over-opinionated commentary, or poor editing. Limited resourceBy Rick Hamml found the information very limited with nothing regrding information on getting from one harbor to another. Since it covers such a wide area, much of

which is not connected by land (not for coastal cruisers), that information would have been helpful. There was no listing of cruising nets for this area.
