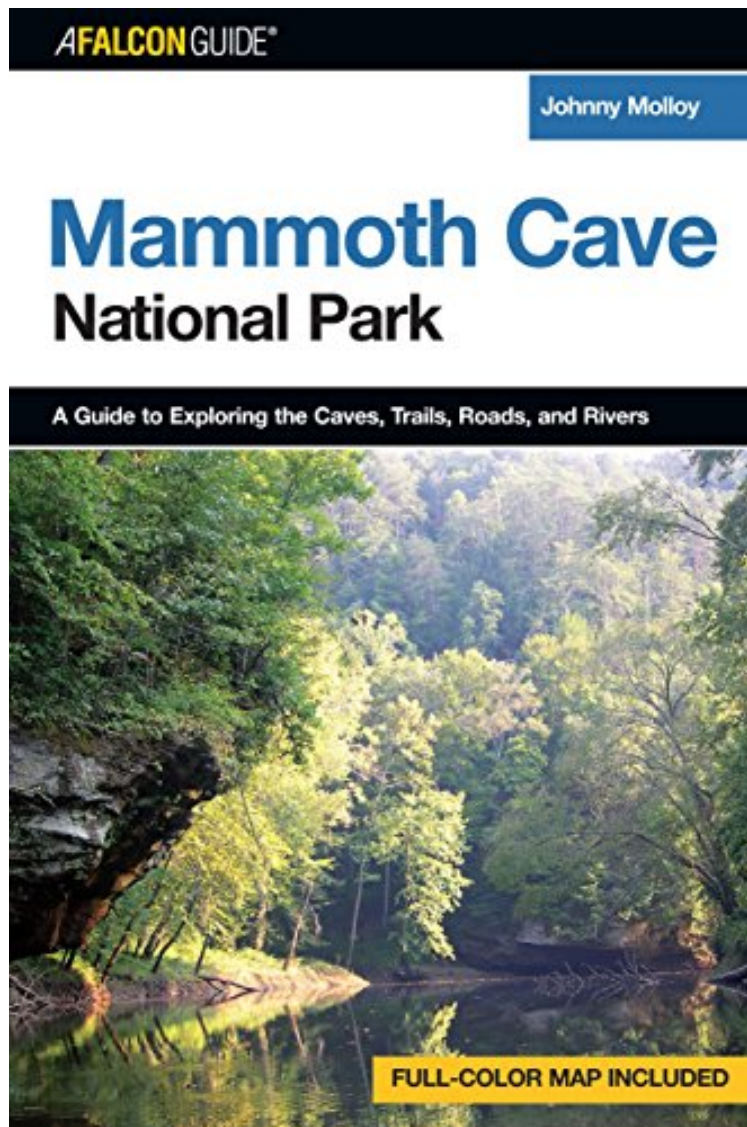

This book also contains descriptions of hiking trails above ground in the park, as well as information on exploring on the rivers and roads. There's even a section detailing local campsites.
