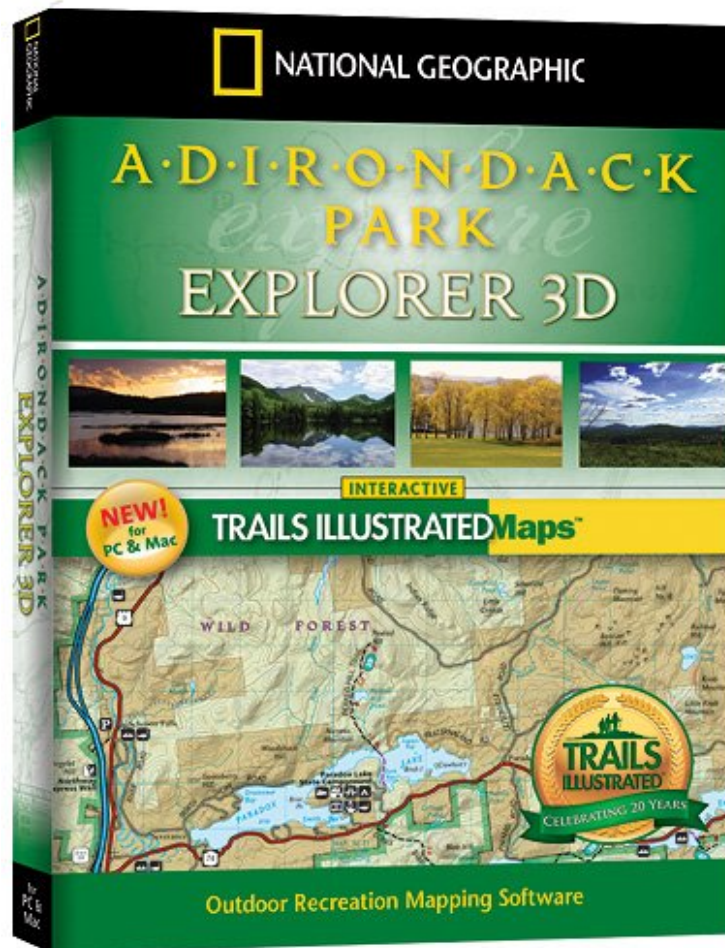

The lengths of each segment of trails are shown clearly and when you hover over a route icon, it gives you more detail. You can also trace a trail with a pen tool and figure out exactly how many miles you will travel. There are also profiles for trails that can be created showing the vertical feet you'll be climbing. Also view maps in 3D and get specific GPS coordinates. Printing this information is also available for hiking. I've printed out maps with my designated routes, sealed them in plastic at Kinkos for weather-proofing and taken them on the trail. This DVD is PC and Mac compatible. Its a gem for planning any hiking or camping trip.
