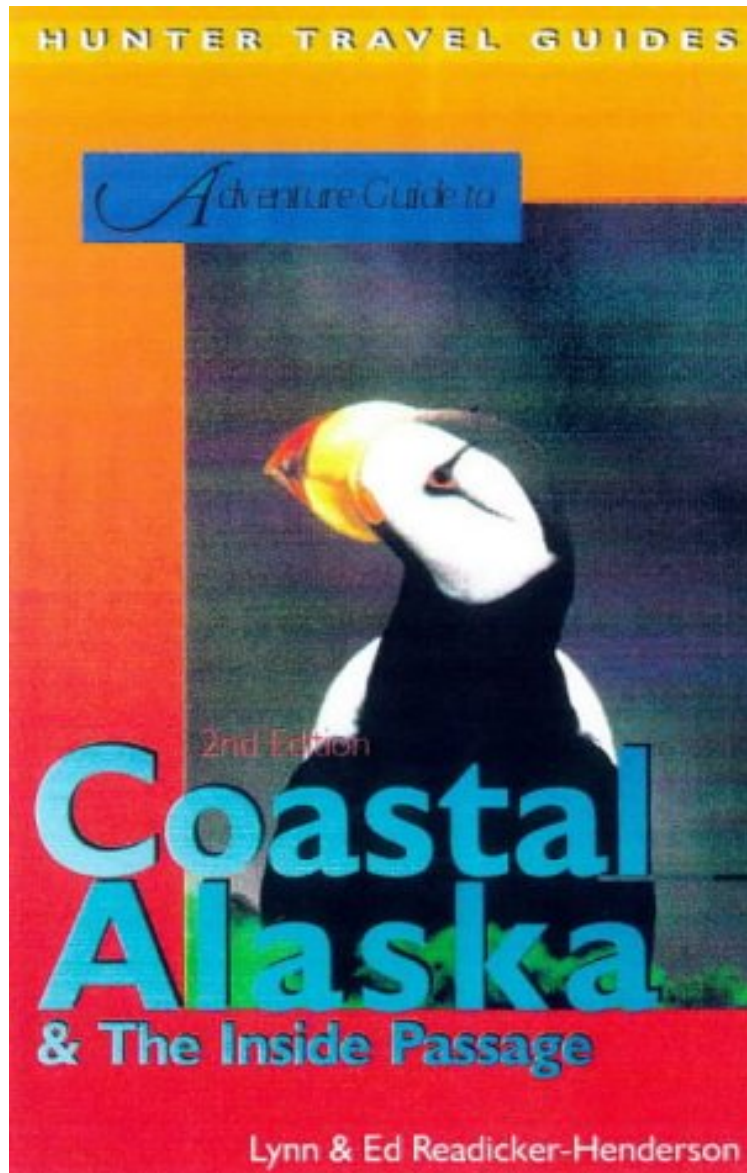

Out of all the travel books I purchased for my Alaska trip this one proved to be the most entertaining and useful. When I received this book I expected just another guide book but I couldn't stop reading - the anecdotes and suggestions were as compelling as a good novel. One draw back is that there are very few maps of the smaller local areas and the maps that are included do not give you a sense of scale.
