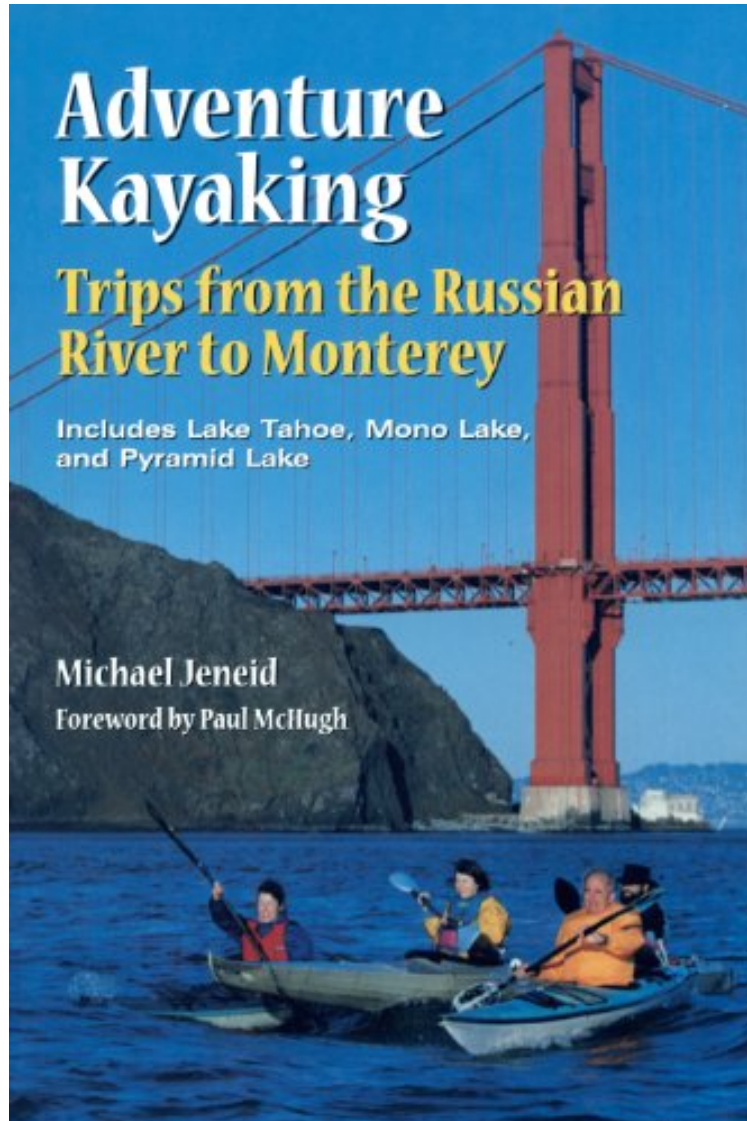

The routes are from the Russian River to Monterey, and several of the major lakes inland to the east; Mono, Tahoe, and Pyramid lakes. I cover how to get to the best places, where to put in, tides and seasonal factors, where to camp and find supplies, where to rent equipment and get professional instruction.
