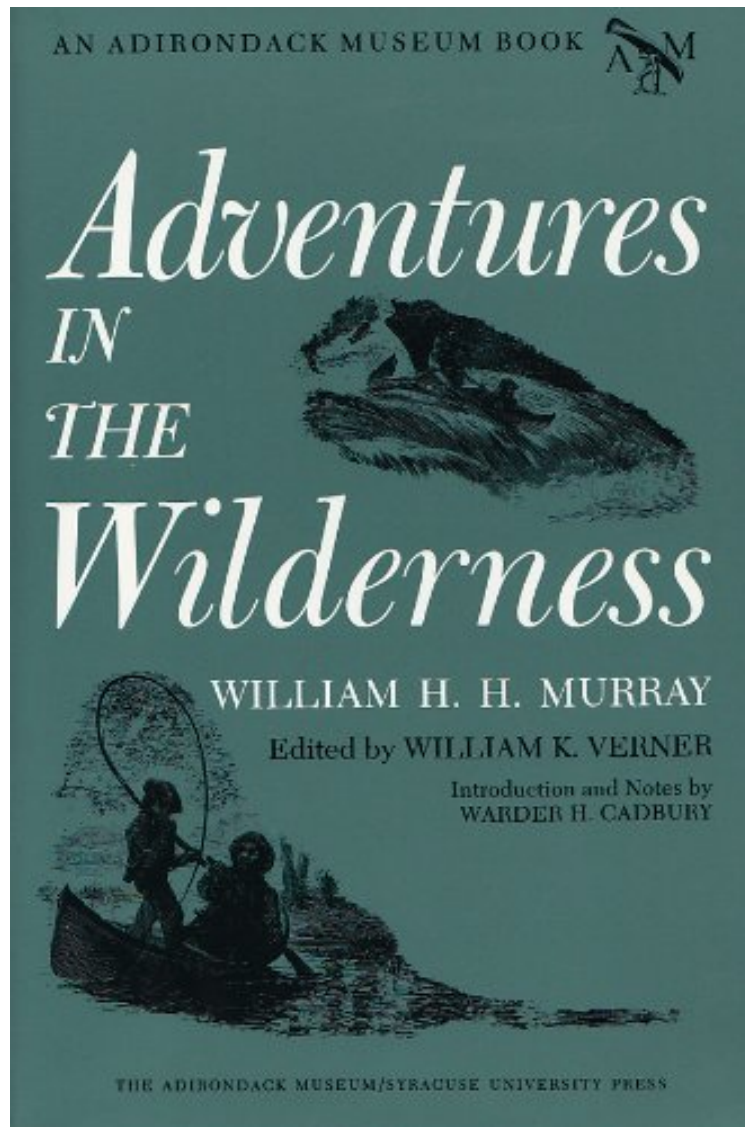

The text is washed out, blotchy and most characters are missing several parts making it extremely difficult to decipher the words. The entire book is like a 300 page "Captcha". It is painful.
