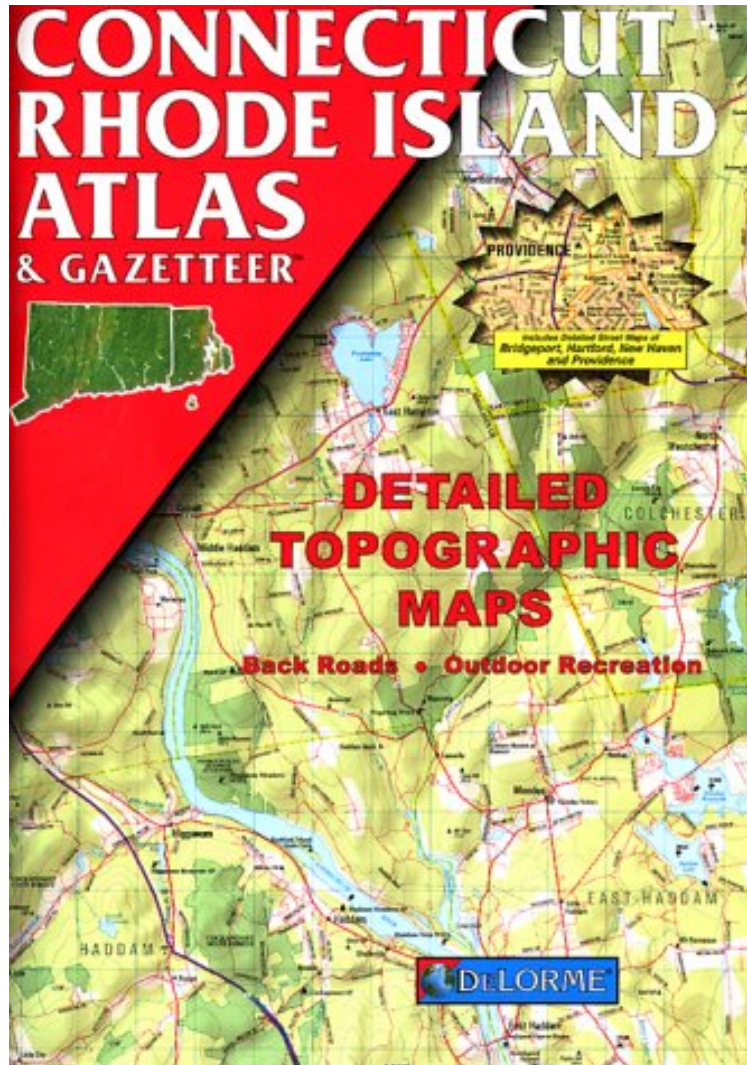

long enough in an area to do some serious exploring of the region I get a Delorme gazetteer for the area. I find that roadmaps are okay if one is just passing through. But, as was the case when I knew I was going to spend several days in Connecticut, I got a gazetteer. This allowed me to find out-of-the-way places as well as backroads that took me to some quite picturesque places, including little streams and ponds, as well as some quaint little hamlets. I was able to get a sense of the local culture that would have been impossible otherwise. And as someone who enjoys hiking, I was able to find hiking trails that provided some great exercise and wonderful scenery. Plus, because it's a topographical map you'll be able to anticipate the terrain you'll encounter whether your on foot or driving.
