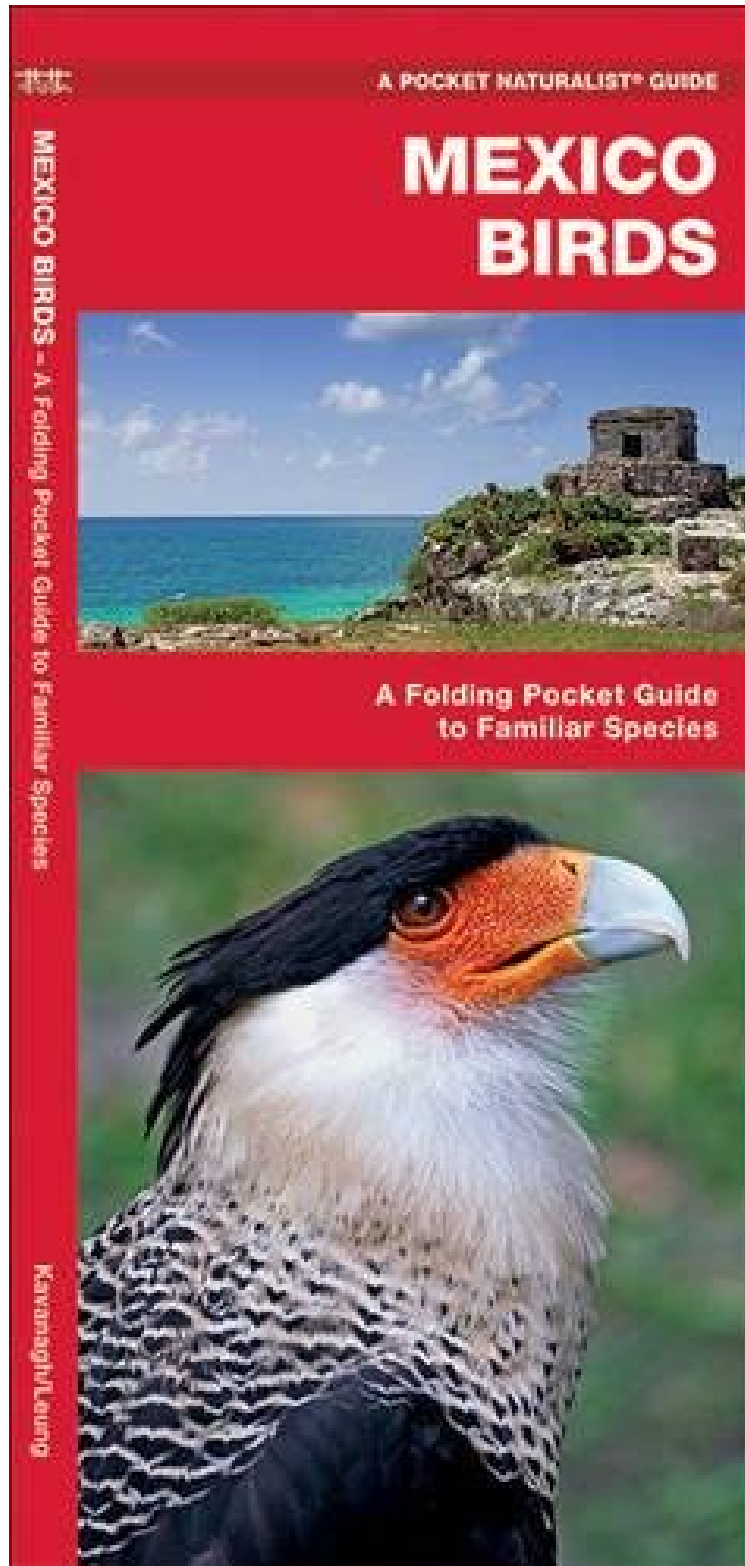

It's very lightweight, and it is sturdily laminated. You could write on it with a grease pencil, then later remove the marks, if you wanted to use it as a checklist. It only shows males in breeding plumage, so females may be difficult to identify with this pamphlet.
