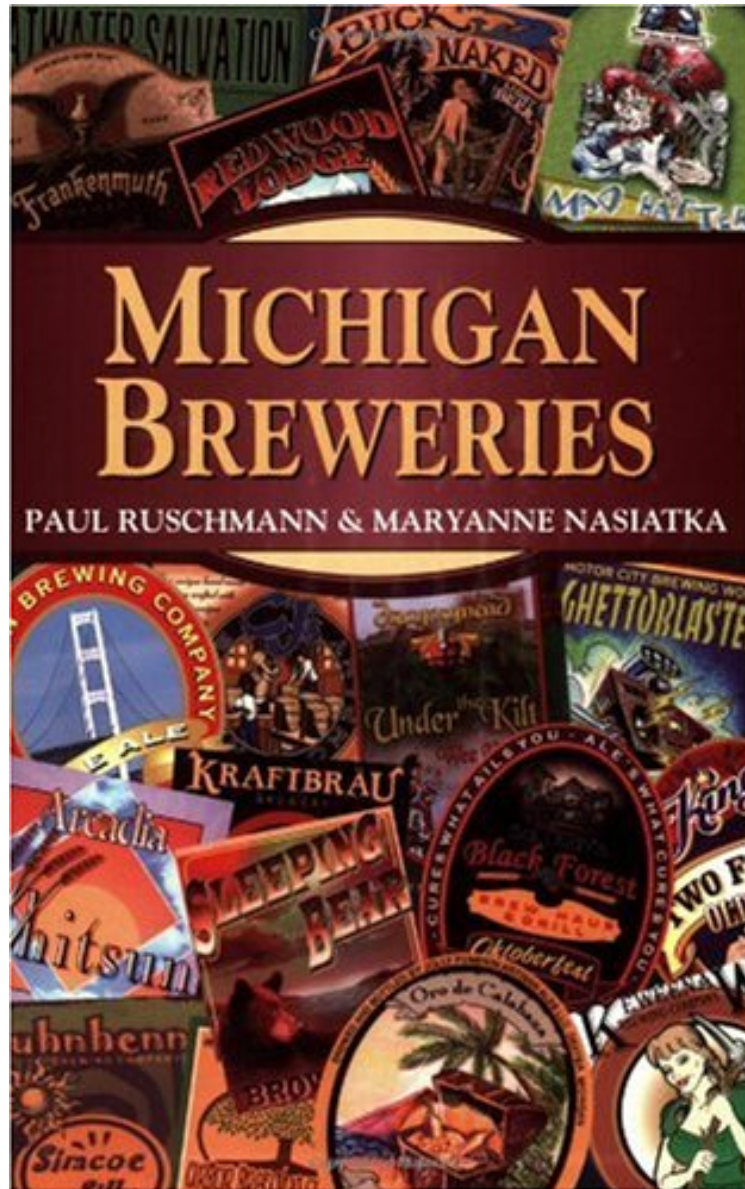

It is NOT, however, a catalog of all the breweries/microbreweries in Michigan. There are several that are missing that come to mind, such as Black Lotus Brewing Company in Clawson, Sherwood Brewing Company in Macomb Township, and The Library in Houghton. These places do seem to come and go, so no blame goes to the authors. Overall, this book is a good buy, and handy to keep if you're a beer lover and travel in Michigan.
