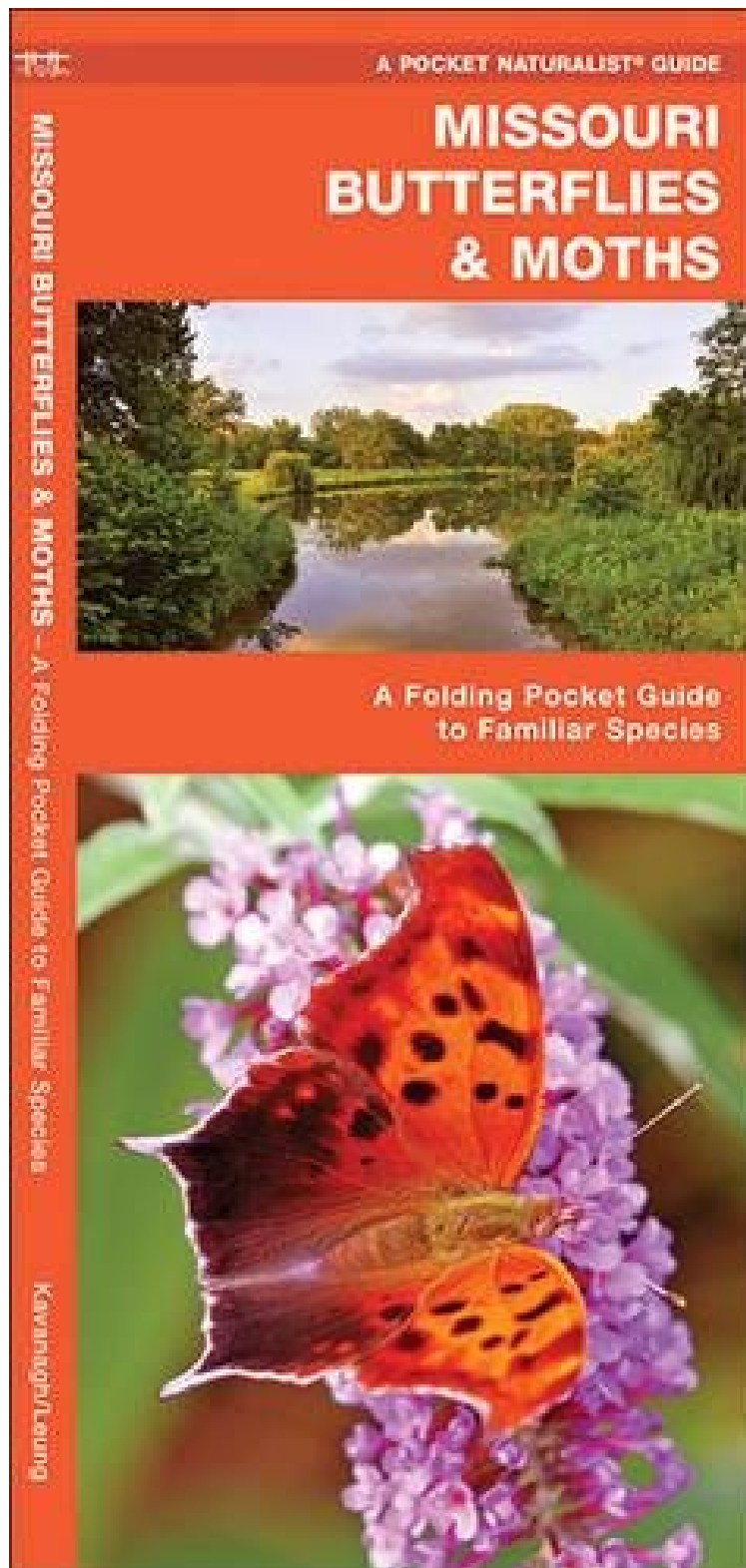

This is not a "true" field guide at all, but rather a pocket-sized pamphlet which only covers about 70 species of butterflies and moths which are found in the state of Missouri. There are hundreds upon hundreds of species found here and I have found that individuals who use this guide end up being frustrated and satisfied when trying to identify specific species. This is a good product to hand out to small school children to stimulate their interest in this subject, but I fear to tell you that they will soon outgrow it and if they have a true interest, then you will be obliged to find a better guide anyway, so you might as well find something a bit better to start with anyway.
