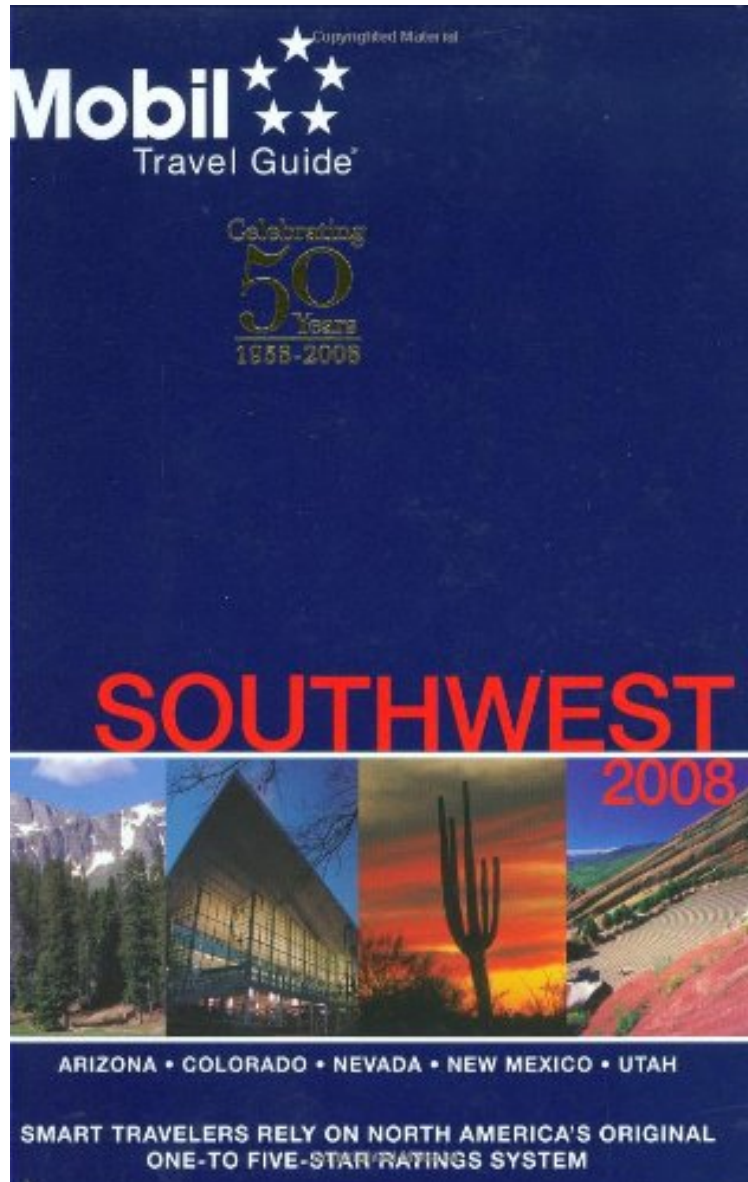

Like on the Las Vegas map in the book, they point out the Liberace Museum but they don't give any details in the information section.This book has a lot of little information in comparision to other guide books.
