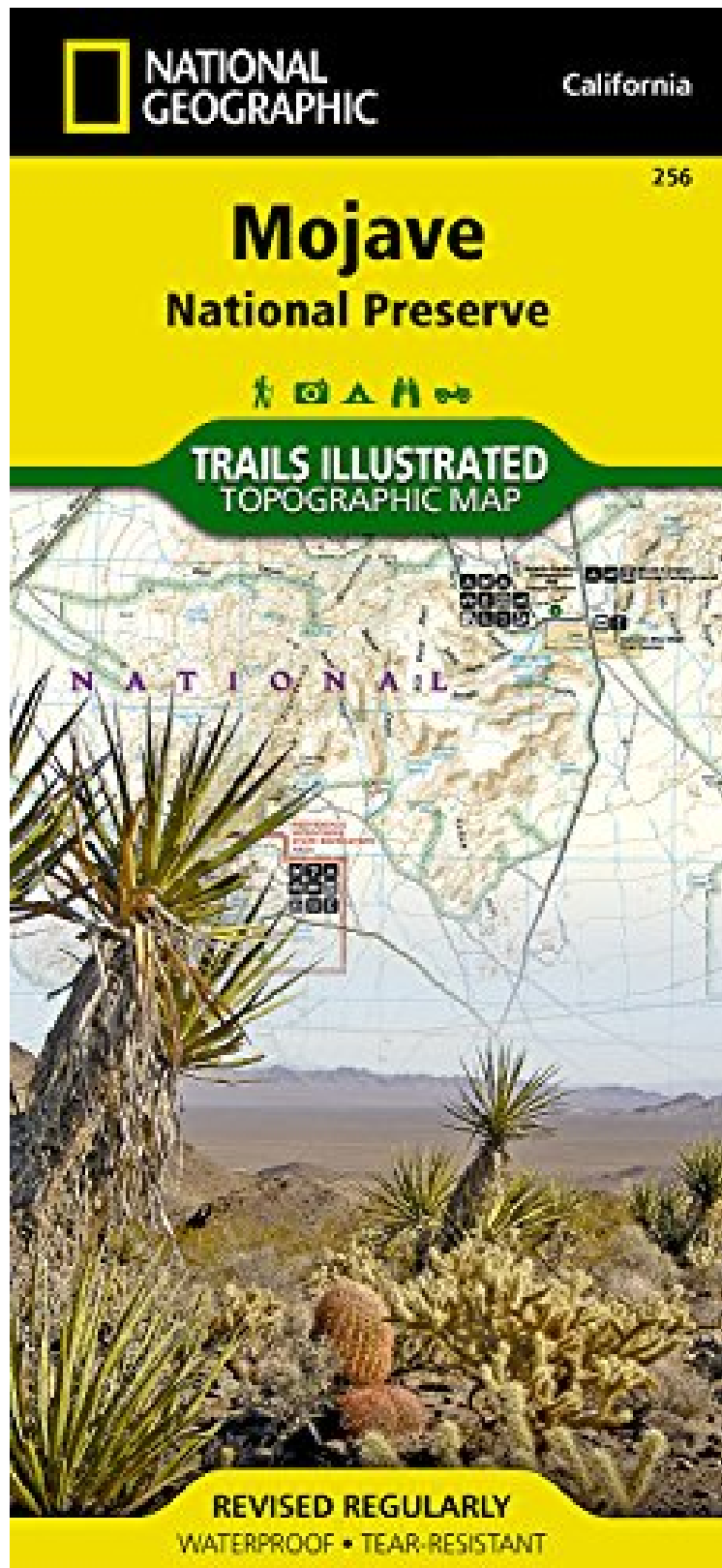

Stone I had a previous version of this map that I have used for years and years. The Trails Illustrated maps have been companions to me for at least a decade. But there's the problem: my existing map is just fine. It's not torn, there are no coffee stains, and it's in great condition. They build these things to last. So my concern was: is there any point to upgrade to a more recent map release? The answer is yes. The detail and information on this map are well worth the investment. The material is even more robust (plastic infused paper or something) than my existing version.
