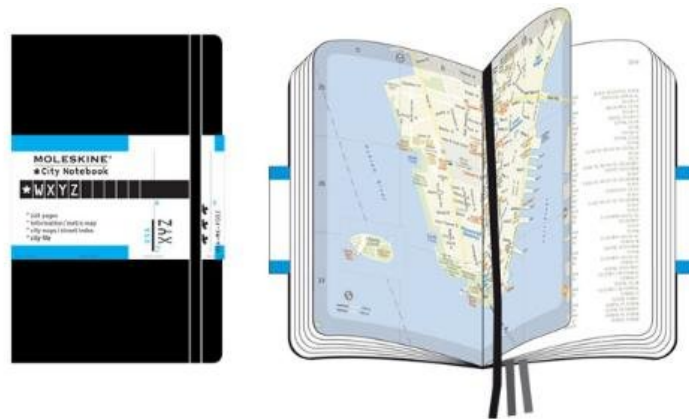

was looking for a planner - what I've been doing is printing out my gcal a few weeks in advance and pasting them into some of the blank pages, for a personalized planner I can write on when I'm in meetings or on the subway. (I plan on getting a new one next year when I run out of extra pages) The maps are very comprehensive, and when I find something in the city I like, or someone recommends a place to me, or I visit a friend's house, I just write it onto the map. Then I've also added a few quick reference pages for myself (yoga schedules, class assignments, lists of books I want to read). I keep an extra metro card in the back pocket for those days when I leave mine in yesterday's pants pocket. So, basically, I'm obsessed with this book, and I use it every few hours. I had been planning on getting a smart phone, but it seems much less necessary now... The only downside? I've only had it four months and it's falling apart because I use it so much. So now I'm on shopping for good book repair tape :(Oh, and one other thing - the regular maps have the subway stops marked but not WHICH subways stop at each one (you have to check the foldout subway map for that). Minor irritation - I just write the subway lines in as I use the stops.
