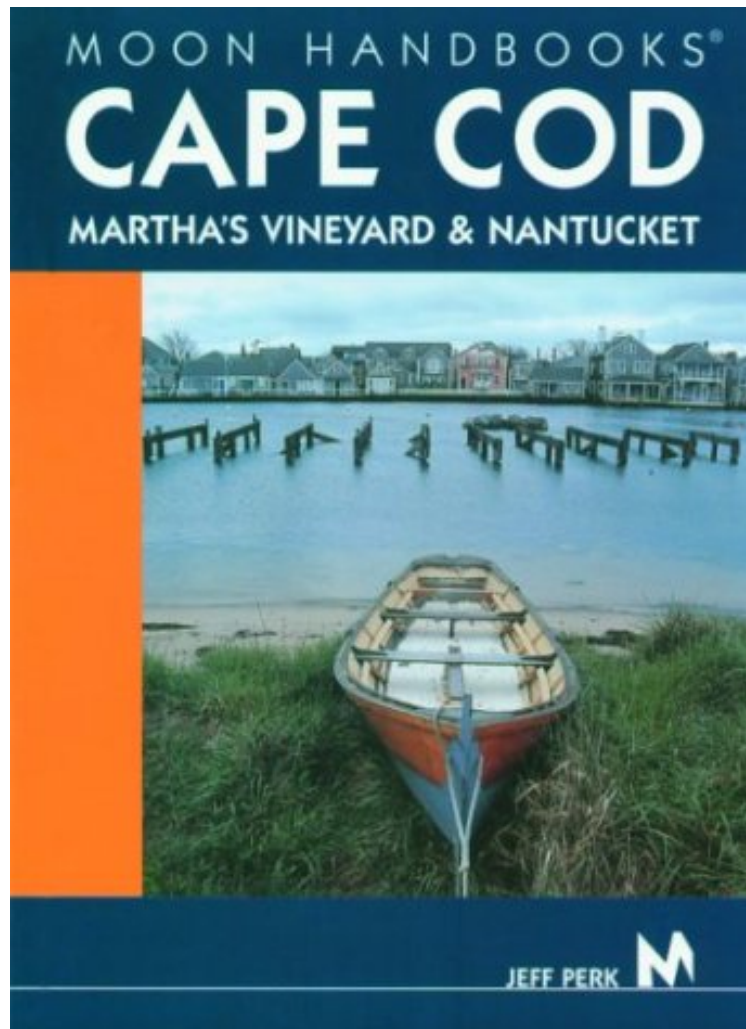

However, this did not deter my research for an up coming trip to the area.This edition of Moon's Cap Code guide provides good information about the area and the sights to see. Compared to the New England edition which also covers Cape Cod, this edition contains more detailed info about the area.Although the accomodation and restuarant section is likely outdated, the general area information is not. A prudent traveler can check opening and closing times for attractions

and activities. This edition is in black and white except for the inside first page and maps. This edition also contains a section on the Elizabeth Islands, which has now been excluded from later editions. Moon puts out some of the better travel books. For anyone researching a trip to the New England and Cape Cod area this book is an excellent starting point for historical information and background.
