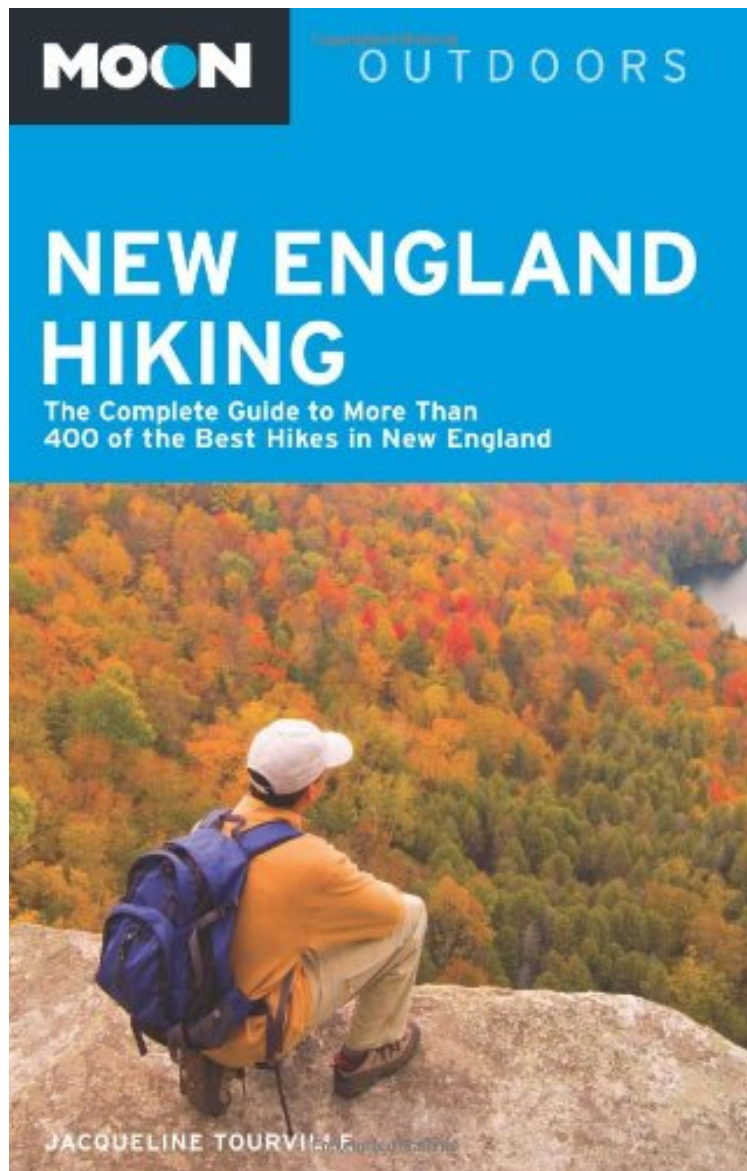

The descriptions are short yet concise, and while there is no hiking maps in the book (there is however an overview map showing the general location of each hike within its respective state), many trail-heads will have a map posted at them that I take a picture of or I follow the accurate description presented in the book. Also, there are GPS coordinates provided in the driving directions of each hike that I can simply plug them into the Google Maps app on my phone and have instant driving directions to the hike. The best part is that all the hikes are rated, and I have found that they are very accurately rated for both difficulty and scenic value. There are no hiking maps in the book though, so be warned about that. For about 300 of the 400 trails, that's totally fine and you likely will not get lost. You should get a separate map for any of the longer-distance or above-treeline hikes. I highly recommend buying a separate map for the White Mountains and another for Acadia National Park.
