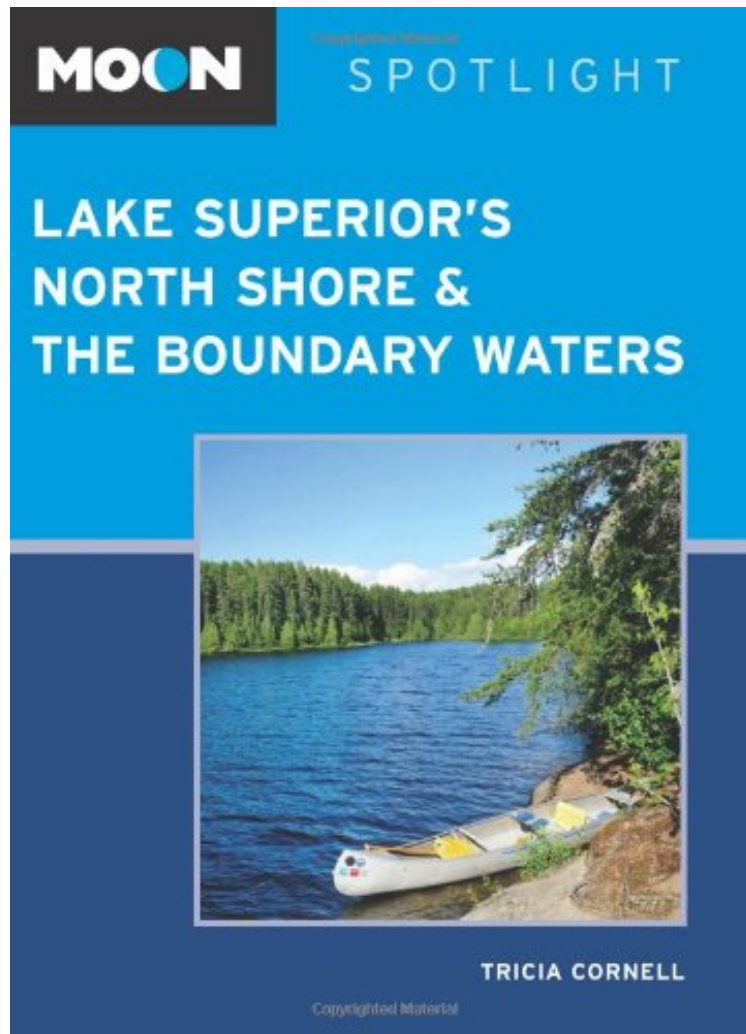

The style is typical of the publisher's other books, and the content is practical, so I think it will be very useful. I am writing this review immediately upon receiving the book to warn purchasers that my copy was apparently an on-demand printed book, and for that reason I am warning customers that you might be dissatisfied by the quality, as I am. Essentially, the printing was faint, and was obviously not done on a professional printing mechanism. The typeface is thin, so that may cause eyestrain while reading. The illustrations are

outright very faint, and .com ought to be ashamed for sending me a book with such poor quality printing. The few maps in the book are also faint (on one map I can see the towns and geographic borders, but the roads do not show!).
