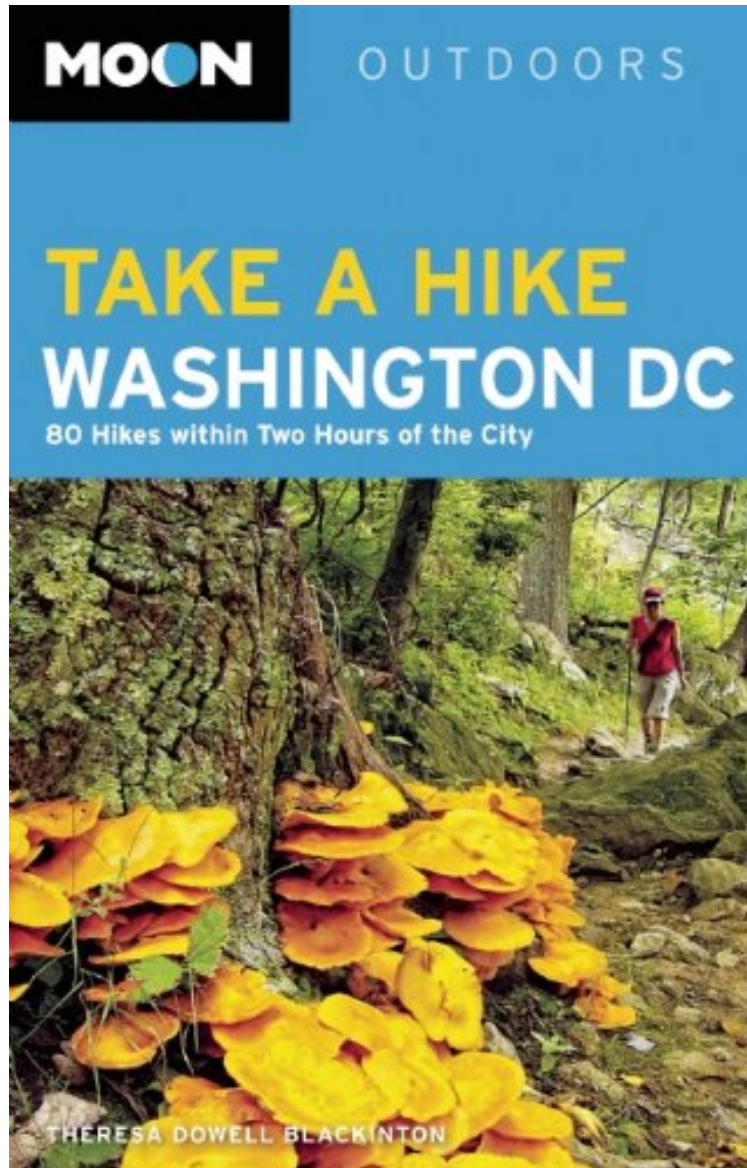

It is great to have a list of local hikes instead of having to sift through the the mass of Google trying to come up with some ideas. We have only done one hike in the book so far, in Greenbriar State Park. Little did we know, and no thanks to the book, Greenbriar State Park is literally in many different locations throughout Maryland. So when we entered this into Google Maps, it took us to another location of this park about an hour away from our intended hike. Also, we noticed that the distances noted for our particular hike were not always accurate. We were hiking through an area that was very overgrown and no trail was visible for some time, and a gravel road and bridge noted along our route were well beyond the expected distances, leaving us concerned about our progress. It's great to have these hike options when you just want to get out the door, but I will proceed more cautiously going forward and will not rely on the author's calculations.
