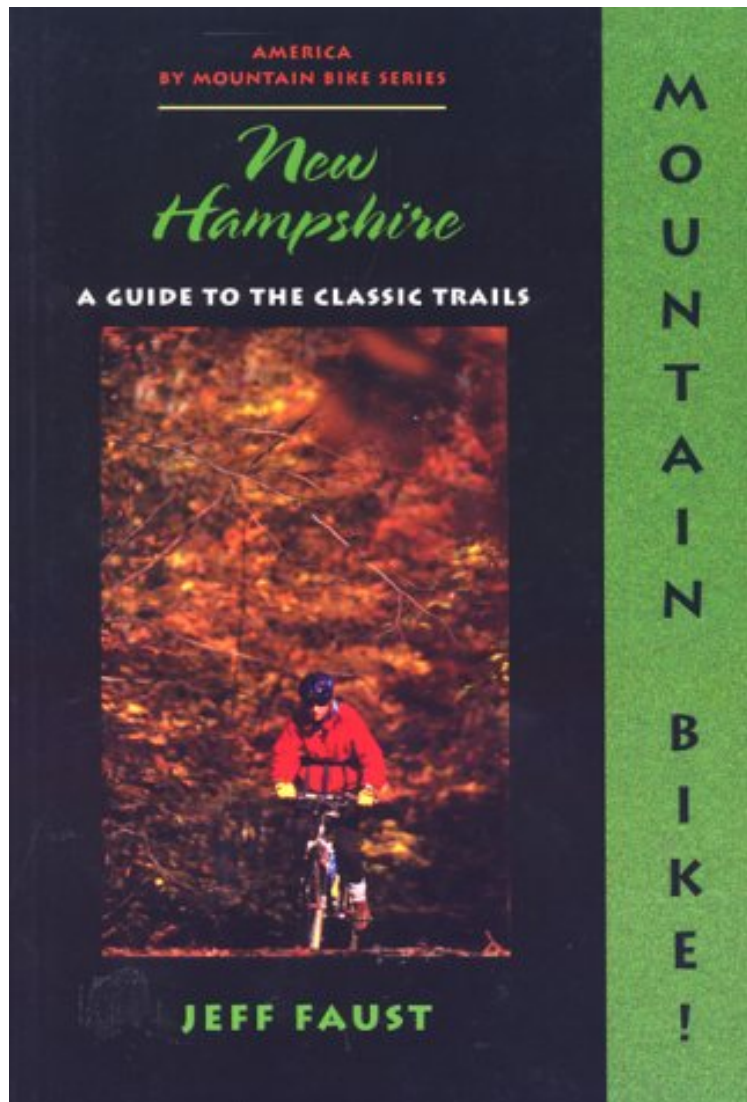

By RobMy wife I bought this book last year to find some new rides close to our home. We finally made it out to New Hampshire this past weekend and chose a ride listed as "Beginner" in the book. What the book called a nice ride, turned out to be nearly impassible single track riddled with boulders roots, not to mention swamp knee deep mudd. We spent the majority of the 12 mile

ride actually walking our bikes. By the end of the trail, we were covered in mud exhausted.
