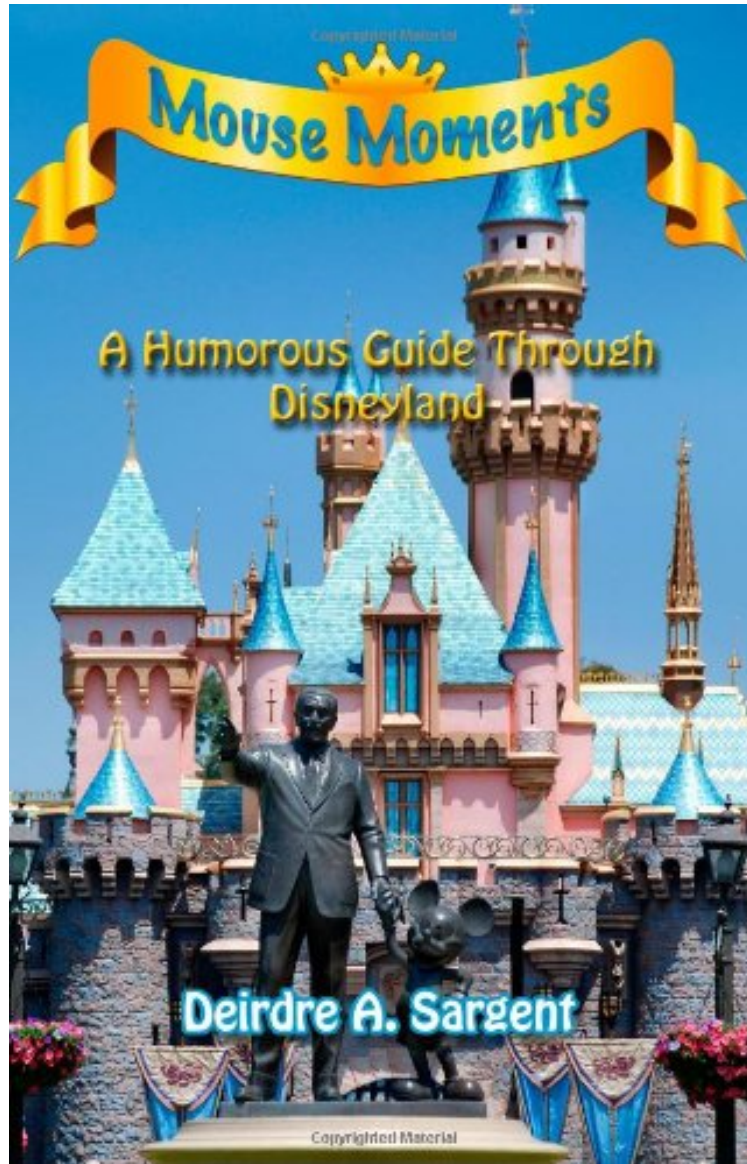

3 of 3 people found the following review helpful. Can I get a refund on this book? By SB-9 The author describes herself as a "satirical humorist" who uses "entertaining anecdotes". I did not find her book satirical, humorous or entertaining. It seems the author was at a loss for adjectives. She (over) used the word "cool" to the point of annoyance. I suppose

she tried appealing to "young people". She used 'dudes', 'awesome', 'hurl' (at least 3 times), 'your thing', 'not into', 'check this out', 'vibe', 'wooged' (referring to the seating on the Matterhorn Bobsled ride), 'it rocks' (describing bacon) and she mentioned - 3 times - how much fun drag queens are if you're in a boat with them on "It's a Small World". There are misspellings and typos - pet peeves of mine, especially in a book! On page 125, the word 'queue' is misspelled 'que'. On page 124, referring to Mickey Mouse, Mickey is spelled with a small 'm'. On page 139, and again on the back cover, Pina Colada is misspelled as 'Pina Colava'.
